

Kansas ArtsVote Pledge (Updated as of 7/29/20)

Ensure Your Vote is COUNTED on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 3, 2020



PRE-REQUISITES

- U.S. Citizen
- At least 18 years of age by Election Day, November 3, 2020
- A Kansas resident
- Have not been convicted of a felony, unless your voting rights have been restored
- Have a Kansas driver's license or other government photo ID

STEP 1 REGISTER TO VOTE & CHECK ACCURACY

Check the Accuracy of your current voter registration or Register to Vote for the first time online or by mail before Tuesday, October 13. If registering by mail, your registration must be POSTMARKED to your County Elections Office by Tuesday, October 13. Don't delay, pledge to check the accuracy of your voter statues or register to vote by August 31.

STEP 2 REQUEST YOUR ABSENTEE BALLOT

Kansas allows the option for all registered voters to request a mail-in ballot (no excuse needed), but you must request a mail-in ballot before Tuesday, October 27; otherwise, you have to physically vote in-person. Kansas will not automatically send mail-in ballots, if not requested. (Note: You must be registered to vote before you can request a mail-in ballot.) Your request for a mail-in ballot must be RECEIVED by your County Elections Office before Tuesday, October 27. **Don't delay, pledge to request your absentee ballot by September 30.**

STEP 3 CAST YOUR VOTE

Cast your vote by **MAILING-IN** your completed and SIGNED mail-in ballot. Your ballot must be POSTMARKED to your <u>County Elections Office</u> by Election Day, Tuesday, November 3. **Don't delay, pledge to mail-in your completed absentee ballot at least two weeks in advance by October 20.**

- OR -

Cast your vote **EARLY IN-PERSON**. Early voting is open from Wednesday, October 14 until Monday, November 2. Early voting dates, locations, and hours vary by county and will become available in October. **Don't delay, pledge to physically cast your vote early before October 20.**

- OR -

Cast your vote **IN-PERSON** at your correct <u>polling place</u> on Election Day, Tuesday, November 3, by 7:00 pm. **Don't delay, pledge to physically cast your vote in the morning on Election Day, November 3.**

STEP 4 CELEBRATE YOUR VOTE
